GREEN PROJECTS



Green Links

This project, funded by the European Union and Sponsored by Bank al Etihad. in partnership with EDAMA Association, Business Development Center, and the Climate Action Network, aims to promote sustainable resource management in Azraq Camp and Zarqa, Jordan. It focuses on encouraging Jordanians and Syrian refugees to engage in organic farming, produce organic compost, and receive training on solar panel system installation and maintenance.

The overarching goal is to foster an integrated approach to the energywater-food nexus by employing circular economy strategies, technologydriven solutions, and community involvement.

Gender Task Force

The Gender Task Force project is funded through a partnership between the German Agency for International Cooperation (GI2), the Jordanian Ministry of Energy and Mineral Resources, EDAMA Association, and the German Energy Agency (dena).

The project aims to promote gender equality and increase the participation and leadership of women in Jordan's energy sector. This initiative works within the framework of the Jordanian German Energy Partnership, focusing on reducing the gender gap and empowering women through various activities such as workshops, surveys, and comprehensive reports.
