1. About EDAMA Association

EDAMA Association for Energy, Water and Environment is a Jordanian non-governmental organization established in 2009. As a business association, EDAMA provides an inclusive platform bringing together public institutions, private sector actors, and civil society to advance sustainable development in the energy, water, and environmental sectors.

EDAMA supports Jordan's transition towards a green and circular economy through innovation, policy dialogue, private sector engagement, and regional cooperation initiatives.

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2. About WEEEVALUE Project

WEEEValue – Promoting Circular Valorization of Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE) is co-funded by the European Union under the Interreg NEXT MED Programme 2021–2027, with a total project budget of approximately €2.48 million (89% EU co-financing). The total eligible direct costs allocated to EDAMA Association for Energy, Water & Environment (PP1) amount to **€211,500** with a duration of **30 months** starting on **November 2025**.

The project aims to improve sustainable WEEE management across the Mediterranean region through enhanced collection systems, reuse and recycling, stakeholder cooperation, and circular economy policy alignment, and pilots four solutions: A transnational methodology for local and regional WEEE strategies, WEEE SOCIAL, WEEE AWARE, and WEEE COLLECT.

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3. Purpose of the Call for Tenders

The purpose of this call for tenders is to select an external service provider to conduct a comprehensive WEEE Market Assessment and Regulatory Diagnosis in Jordan, within the framework of Activity 3.1.1 of WEEEVALUE project (A_T_2.4_0613).

As Coordinator of Work Package 3 (WP3), EDAMA leads the delivery of the Market Assessment prior to the development of the Transnational Methodology for the design of WEEE strategies. This specific service focuses on producing a comprehensive diagnosis of the WEEE market in Jordan, covering the regulatory and policy framework, the technical status of the circular economy value chain, and the identification of key stakeholders. The resulting report will serve as the baseline for the Local Action Plan (LAP) and feed directly into the Transnational Methodology.

4. Scope of Services

The provider will conduct a comprehensive diagnosis of the WEEE market for the contracting body. The service includes gathering data on the 5 steps of the circular economy (Prevention, Reuse, Recycling, Recovery, and Disposal) and the production of a technical report identifying the circularity potential of the region. The market assessment is crucial to bridge the disparities between territories and to address the challenge of illegal e-waste shipments by building a transnational network of knowledge.

A comprehensive technical assessment organized in two phases will be delivered:

Phase I – Regulatory and Policy Framework Analysis

The provider will analyse the current legislative environment regarding WEEE, focusing on:

- **Regulatory disparities:** Identifying differences between the contracting territory and the WEEE Directive 2012/19/EU (especially the 65% collection rate target).
- **Illegal shipment monitoring:** Assessment of current monitoring systems (or lack thereof) to prevent illegal e-waste movement, as highlighted in the project's transnational dimension.
- **Licensing systems:** Evaluation of current licensing for collection points and collectors.

Phase II – Technical Diagnosis: Circular Economy Value Chain

The assessment must provide a detailed map of:

- **Waste streams:** Current generation rates vs. collection rates at the source.
- **Infrastructure status:** Analysis of existing "Biological Mechanical Treatment" plants or bulky waste facilities.
- **Circular hierarchy:** Assessment of the territory's performance in Prevention, Reuse, Recycling, Recovery, and Disposal.
- **Skill needs:** Identifying gaps in technical knowledge for the transition from a linear to a circular EE sector.

5. Deliverables of the Service

The provider shall submit the following deliverables:

1. **Draft Market Assessment Report:** Preliminary findings including the analysis of the regulatory and policy framework and the technical diagnosis.
2. **Final WEEE Market Assessment Report:** A comprehensive technical document (in English) providing the baseline for the Transnational Methodology and the foundation for the area's Local Action Plan (LAP).

6. Evaluation Criteria

Offers will be evaluated based solely on the financial offer submitted by the tenderer. The contract shall be awarded to the technically compliant offer presenting the lowest total price.

7. Payment Terms

Payment shall be in instalments linked to the formal acceptance of each deliverable by EDAMA.

8. Submission Requirements

The tender file must include the following documents:

- **Company or individual profile**, including legal registration and relevant experience,
- **Technical offer**, detailing the proposed methodology, work plan, and timeline for all three phases.
- **Financial offer**, providing a clear cost breakdown per deliverable, quoted in EUR or JOD.
- **Proof of legal registration**, such as a valid commercial registration certificate or equivalent official document for individuals.

The service provider shall sign and date the tender file, including the technical and financial offers. Service fees must be final, quoted in **EUR or JOD**, and inclusive of all applicable taxes. Where fees are quoted in JOD, conversion to EUR shall be made using the InfoEuro exchange rate applicable for the month in which the expenditure was incurred, in accordance with Interreg NEXT MED Programme rules.
